Please note that due to the design of some of the stencils, it may be necessary to have additional plastic attachments connecting the inside areas of the stencil to the outside of the stencil. This in no way will affect the ultimate look of the stencil on your strings.

Multi-Color Stencil Instructions

<p>Step 1 You will notice that your stencil has arrows in the top and bottom of the stencil. These are to aid in the layout of the design on the strings. Using the arrows, place “Stencil A, Side 1” facing up on the strings where desired. Note that if your stencil design contains the additional plastic attachments try to place these in between the strings so that the strings can be inked fully.</p>	
<p>Step 2 Shake the RacquetArt Stencil Ink container for at least 30 seconds vigorously to mix the ink. Remove the cover and push down the felt tip onto a paper towel folded over a few times to load the ink into the felt tip.</p>	
<p>Step 3 While holding the stencil in place, run the felt tip applicator of the RacquetArt Stencil Ink over the exposed strings. Ensure that all the strings inside the stencil are covered in ink.</p>	
<p>Step 4 When finished with the first side, remove the stencil from the racquet. Turn the racquet AND the stencil over. Lay the stencil on the strings aligning it with the image from the other side with “Stencil A, Side 2” showing on the stencil. Once aligned, repeat the inking of the strings as you did on the first side in Step 3.</p>	
<p>Step 5 Remove Stencil A from the strings. If your design had any plastic attachments, fill in these areas on the strings with the RacquetArt Stencil Ink. You are now done with Stencil A. Repeat Steps 1 through 5 using Stencil B and the second color of ink.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">ENJOY YOUR WORK OF RACQUETART.</p>
